This material is a special formulation of Captan and Maneb which, when used at the correct application rates, protects seeds and seedlings against seed-borne or soil-borne diseases such as damping-off, root rot, seed decay and seedling blight.

RECOMMENDATIONS and DIRECTIONS FOR USE
PLANTER BOX OR DRILL BOX APPLICATION

Use on seed by mixing with the seed in the box at the rate shown below. DO NOT MIX WITH HANDS.

Planter Box or Drill Box Rates:

Wheat, oats, barley, rye	4 to 6 oz./bu.
Corn seed (field)	4 to 6 oz./bu.
Soybeans, beans, peas	4 to 6 oz./bu.
Peanuts (shelled)	4 to 6 oz./100#

Slurry Treatment

Mix 1 lb. of this material with 1 gal. of water in the slurry machine. Settings of the machinery can be adjusted to apply the rates listed above to the seed. Further specific information on this subject may be obtained from State Agricultural Experiment Stations or the State Agricultural Extension Service.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for human consumption nor as animal feed. Bags containing treated seed should be labeled:

TREATED SEED

DO NOT USE FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL PURPOSES
