STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

First Aid

Immediately start the procedures given below and CONTACT A POISON CENTER, A PHYSICIAN, OR THE NEAREST HOSPITAL or call collect, day or night, (203) 226-6602 Stauffer Chemical Company or (800) 424-9300 Pesticide Safety Team Network. Describe the type and extent of exposure, the victim's symptoms and follow the advice given.

Ingestion

If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water and induce vomiting by placing a finger on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until the vomitus is clear. If victim is unconscious or convulsing, do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth.

Skin Contact

For skin contact, flush affected areas with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove and clean contaminated clothing and shoes. Seek medical attention if irritation occurs.

Eye Contact

For eye contact, hold eyelids apart and flush eyes with large amounts of running water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation occurs.

Inhalation

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, clear victim's airway and start mouth-to-mouth artificial respiration. If victim is breathing, oxygen may be given from a demand-type or continuous-flow inhaler, preferably with a physician's advice. Get medical attention immediately.
