USE PRECAUTIONS

RECOMMENDATIONS AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of Chinch Bug in established ornamental turf in Southeastern United States.

DO NOT PREWATER THE TURF AREA.

Apply at first sign of insects or insect damage. Use 150 to 200 pounds per acre (3½ to 4⅔ pounds per 1,000 square feet) applied uniformly with a granular pesticide applicator. Immediately after application, water the treated turf thoroughly for 10 to 15 minutes to wash the product into the root zone. Retreat as needed to keep local infestations under control.
