

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals

WARNING:

May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Thoroughly wash skin or clothing with soap and water if they become contaminated.

When used in dwellings, avoid deposits which could be frequently contacted by children. Do not permit children or pets in treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Statement of Practical Treatment:

If poisoning occurs or is suspected, immediately start the recommended procedures below and simultaneously contact a physician, the nearest hospital, or a poison control center for advice.

NOTE: Be sure to advise the physician that the compound is a cholinesterase inhibitor and follow his or her advice.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. This product contains hydrocarbon solvent. Immediately give large quantities of water. If vomiting does occur, give fluids again. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

For eye contact, hold eyelids apart and flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

For skin contact, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if irritation occurs. Wash clothing before reuse.

If inhaled, remove from contaminated atmosphere. Get medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal when administered early and in conjunction with atropine.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Combustible. Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed when not in use.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

SUMITHION 8E is an emulsifiable concentrate containing 8 lbs. of SUMITHION per gallon. After dilution with water it is intended for use by Professional Applicators for residual cockroach control in buildings and structures and in modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to: stores, warehouses, industrial buildings, houses, apartment buildings, and on vessels, aircraft, rail cars, buses, trucks, and trailers.

The solvent used in this formulation is a petroleum distillate which may stain certain plastic, rubber, and asphalt materials such as tiles and floor coverings. Use caution when treating such materials. Care should also be taken to avoid spotting of wallpaper and fabrics.

COCKROACHES

For control of cockroaches, dilute SUMITHION as shown below to make a 1% spray and

Gallons of Finished Spray Required	Amount of SUMITHION 8-E

Apply as a coarse low pressure spot spray with paint brush to areas where cockroaches hide: boards; storage areas; around water pipes; refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, and stove shelves, drawers, and similar areas; behind pallets, and similar areas where cockroaches which they may enter. Treated areas should be rechecked 4 weeks after initial application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- 1. PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal. Open flames prohibited.

COCKROACHES

For control of cockroaches, dilute SUMITHION 8-E with water as shown below to make a 1% spray and apply as indicated.

Gallons of Finished Spray Required	Amount of SUMITHION 8-E Required
1	1 1/4 fl. oz.
2	2 1/2 fl. oz.
3	3 3/4 fl. oz.
10	12 1/2 fl. oz.
25	31 1/4 fl. oz.

Apply as a coarse low pressure spot spray, or apply with a paint brush to areas where cockroaches hide such as baseboards; storage areas; around water pipes; behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, and stoves; the underside of shelves, drawers, and similar areas; behind and below lockers, pallets, and similar areas where cockroaches hide or through which they may enter. Treated area should be inspected 2 and 4 weeks after initial application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- 1. PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
- 2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.
