REWARD/TREFLAN* 4-E/METRIBUZIN TANK MIX DIRECTIONS

It is a viclation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

How to use REWARD and TREFLAN 4-EC and METRIBUZIN (4-L or 50-WP) as a spray tank mix.

A tank mix of REWARD (6 pounds active ingredient per gallon) and TREFLAN 4-EC (4 pounds active ingredient per gallon) and METRIBUZIN 4-L (4 pounds active ingredient per gallon) or METRIBUZIN 50-WP (50% active ingredient by weight) can be used prior to planting for weed control in soybeans.

The combination will control a broader spectrum of weeds than the REWARD/TREFLAN 4- EC tank mix. *TREFLAN is the registered trademark of Elanco Products Company

Medium (sitt loam & sandy clay soils)	2½ to 3½ pints	1 pint	% pint or % pound
Fine (heavy-clay soils)	3% pints	1 pint	½ pint or ½ pound

**For nulsedge, wild cane, and velvelleaf control, use the high rate of 3½ pints of REWARD on medium textured soils

Do not use the REWARD/TREFLAN/METRIBUZIN tank mix on coarse (light sandy) soils.

Cultivation is suggested in addition to REWARD/TREFLAN 4-EC:/METRIBUZIN (4-L or 50-WP) treatment in fields with moderate to heavy infestations of nutgrass, wild cane, and velvetleaf.
