First Aid

If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately initiate the recommended procedures below. If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water and induce vomiting by gagging the victim with a finger placed on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. If victim is unconscious or convulsing, do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth.

For skin contact, flush all affected areas with plenty of water for several minutes. For eye contact, hold eyelids apart and flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Remove and clean contaminated clothing and shoes before re-use. Seek medical attention if skin or eye irritation occurs.
