Apply 60 to 80 pounds of SHORT-STOP per acre of utility turf. Use the higher rate when tall fescue is over 4 inches in height. The number of acres in a mile of a narrow swath is equal to the swath width in feet divided by 8.25. For example, in a 12-foot wide swath there are  $12/8.25 = 1.4545$  acres per mile. Five miles of such a swath would be equal to  $5 \times 1.4545 = 7.27$  acres.

Application must be made within 4 weeks of the time that tall fescue breaks winter dormancy. Use any granular applicator that will provide a uniform distribution of granules over the entire swath area.






