STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Call a Poison Center or a Physician Immediately.

If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately start the procedures given below. Simultaneously contact a poison center, a physician or the nearest hospital.

NOTE: Advise the person contacted that the active ingredient in this product is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Describe the type and extent of exposure, the victim's symptoms, and follow the advice given.

NOTE TO MEDICAL PERSONNEL: Atropine by injection is antidotal for cholinesterase inhibition. Pralidoxime chloride (Protopam, 2-PAM) is also antidotal when administered early and in conjunction with atropine.

If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water and induce vomiting by placing a finger on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. If victim is unconscious or convulsing, do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, oxygen may be given with a physician's advice. If not breathing, clear victim's airway and start mouth-to-mouth artificial respiration and get medical attention.

If on skin, flush affected areas with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove and clean contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if skin irritation persists.

If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush eyes with large amounts of running water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if eye irritation occurs.

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

WHEN TO APPLY: FIREBAN can be applied at any time during the year. For best results, apply FIREBAN either early morning or late afternoon.

#### APPLICATION METHODS

##### DIRECT APPLICATION

EQUIPMENT: Garden hose.

APPLICATION: Use one FIREBAN packet for each square foot of mound. Use scissors to open outer foil packet along indicated line and allow unopened inner packet to drop on the fire ant mound. Immediately water the packet and the mound until the packet and its contents are completely dissolved.

##### MOUND DRENCH APPLICATION

EQUIPMENT: Two gallon sprinkler can or two gallon bucket.

MIXING AND APPLICATION: Use one FIREBAN packet for each square foot of mound. For small mounds (one square foot or less), use scissors to open outer foil packet along indicated line and allow unopened inner packet to drop into two gallons of water in a sprinkler can or bucket. Mix thoroughly until the packet is dissolved. Wet the mound with the FIREBAN solution to soften the crust. Then thoroughly drench the mound and the surrounding three foot area with the FIREBAN solution. For best results, start at the outer edge of the area to be treated and work toward the center of the mound, making sure that the entire area is treated with the solution.

For larger mounds (greater than one square foot) use the same procedure but add another FIREBAN packet and increase the volume of water by two gallons for each additional one square foot in mound size.

Do not apply to mounds in food or feed crops.

IMPORTANT: Except for the application procedure, do not disturb mound before or during treatment.

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PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

When mixing wear mid forearm to elbow length chemical resistant gloves, long sleeve shirt, and long pants. During the application wear long sleeve shirt and long pants.

Any article of clothing worn while applying product must be cleaned before re-using. Clothing should be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing which has been drenched or has otherwise absorbed concentrated pesticide must be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, incinerated, or burned if allowed by state and local authorities.
