STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Immediately start the procedures given below. If further treatment is needed, contact a Poison Center, a Physician, the nearest hospital, or Stauffer Medical Emergency Assistance, collect (203) 226-6602.

If in eyes, hold eyelids apart, flush with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes, and get medical attention.

If on skin, wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Remove and clean contaminated clothing.

If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water but do not make person vomit. Contact a physician immediately.

Note to Medical Personnel: For emergency medical information, contact a Poison Center, a Physician, or call collect, (203) 226-6602. This product contains a petroleum solvent and also is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition develop, atropine by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal but only when given in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Protect from temperatures below 42°F. At temperatures below 42°F, product may crystalize. Dissolve crystals with quiet storage at warm temperatures (60°F). - Shake well before using.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container, including any unused product, in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

For use on grass and dichondra lawns for control of crabgrass. Handy Spray BETASAN® Crabgrass Preventer can be applied to dichondra lawns at the time of seeding or any time thereafter. On grass lawns do not reseed within 4 months after application.

Where germination of crabgrass extends into the late summer and early fall, a second application should be made 4 to 5 months after the initial application.

Application of this product must precede emergence of weeds from the soil. Crabgrass will emerge from the soil from 4 to 6 weeks before it is visible above lawn sod. If weeds are visible above the soil, it is too late to apply Handy Spray BETASAN® Crabgrass Preventer.

Remove leaves, dead tall grass, and other debris before application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HOW TO USE:

Shake well before using.

1. Attach spray nozzle to garden hose. Turn nozzle clockwise to firmly attach it to hose.
2. Remove child resistant cap from bottle (directions on cap) and screw bottle into spray nozzle.
3. Turn the on/off switch on top of the spray nozzle counter clockwise to the "OFF" position. Then turn on water at the faucet.
4. To begin spraying, turn the sprayer nozzle switch clockwise to the "ON" position. The water automatically mixes with the product. Walk at a steady pace spraying in a side to side arc, slightly overlapping treated areas and covering 2500 sq. ft. from this package. Refer to graduated scale on side of container to guide coverage.
5. To stop spraying, turn the sprayer nozzle switch counter clockwise to the "OFF" position and turn off water at the faucet.
