

Bug Killer



Kills fast on contact Kills a variety of bugs indoors and outdoors

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING-HOLD CONTAINER UP. RIGHT. Keep nozzle 3 feet from indoor surfaces.

Indoors: Close all doors and windows. Pointing nozzle upward, fill the room with mist. Leave the treated area closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

Outdoors: Holding container about 24" from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas, spray with a slow, sweeping motion while moving away from area being treated. Spray with the breeze, allowing mist to drift into shrubbery and other places. Repeat as necessary. As an area spray, mist porches, patios, and picnic

areas. Repeat as necessary.

Spray directly on insects when possible. Spray baseboards, cracks and crevices, and other hiding places such as in back of and under appliances, sinks, and cupboards in the kitchen. Repeat as necessary.

Outdoors: For certain ornamental flowers, such as Roses, Gladiola, Azaleas, Chrysanthemuma, and other flowering, garden, and house plants, evergreens and deciduous shrubs, spray with a slow, sweeping motion 18" from all plants. "Avoid wetting-a light spray kills bugs effectively. Spray plants in short bursts and only when air is still and when temperature is below 90° F. Repeat as needed. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of food, Cover or remove fish bowls and remove pets.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or throw container into fire. Do not store in direct sunlight, on stoves, radiators, or any place where temperature exceeds 120° F., which may cause container to burst.
