Your Application Dated February 26, 1993
Requesting and Amendment to the Label

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) Due to new EPA policy, which is an amendment to P.R. Notice 93-3, part of the Environmental Hazards section has been changed. To comply, change the sentence "Do not apply to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes)" to read "Do not apply directly to water."
- 2) The label does not clearly state the product's intended use. In order for this label to be accepted, it must clearly specify the intended use for spot-spraying only individual weeds. Under Directions for Use add the following statement:

"This product is intended for spot-spraying individual weeds only."

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit five (5) final printed copies for the referenced label, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment.

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Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. Use strictly in accordance with label cautions, warnings and directions and in conformity with Federal and State regulations.

Turn adjustable nozzle by rotating to deliver a jet stream. A jet stream is less likely to drift. Stand as close to weeds as possible. No need to stoop or squat with jet stream weed gun. Drench leaves and stems of weeds. Spray thoroughly to completely wet weeds. One application will kill most broadleaf weeds. (Repeat application if it rains within 24 hours). If certain tough weeds are not dead in three weeks, repeat application. After application, weeds sprayed may flourish for a short time. The ingredients force the weeds to grow so fast that the whole plant dies.

Other Precautions: Do not allow spray to drift onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants since injury may result. Do not pour spray solutions near these plants. Avoid fine-mist sprays. Coarse spray droplets are less likely to wind-drift and cause damage to non-target plants. Do not spray roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Do not exceed specified dosage; be particularly careful within dripline of tree and other ornamental species. This product is intended for spot-spraying individual weeds only. Certain grasses, such as Bent grass, St. Augustine, Dichondra, Carpet grass or clover lawns are sensitive to herbicides and may be temporarily injured. *Do not use on Floratam grass in Florida.*

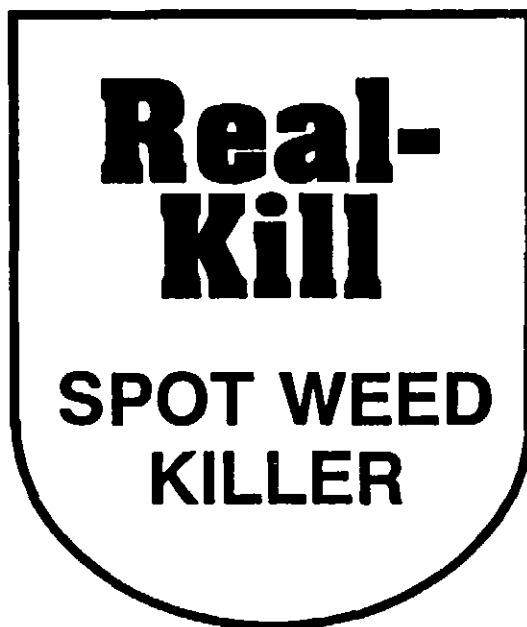
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat, direct sunlight, or open flame. Keep from freezing. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
