

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply directly to food in commercial food handling facility. Cover or remove any food utensils and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in packing plant, bakery and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with potable water.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin:** Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Storage: Store in a cool place away from heat, direct sunlight, or open flame. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area. **Disposal:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

FOR INSECT CONTROL ON ORNAMENTALS, VEGETABLES, AND FLOWERING PLANTS

Roses and Ornamentals such as Azaleas, Chrysanthemums, Astors, Marigolds, Petunias, Nasturtiums, Gladioli, Salvia, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Iris, Snapdragons, and other flowering plants; evergreens, and deciduous shrubs and vines.

To Control: Aphids, Spider Mite, Thrips, White Flies, Rose Chafers, Climbing Cutworm, Leaf Hopper Nymphs, Japanese Beetles, Lace Bugs and Lygus Bugs.

Vegetables: tomatoes, beans, cabbage, potatoes, corn, peas, cucumbers and peppers.

To Control: Aphids, Bean Leaf Beetles, Corn Ear Worm, Cabbage Worms, Cucumber Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetle, Japanese Beetle.

DIRECTIONS: Pour 8 fluid ounces into REAL-KILL Rose & Garden Insect Spray Gun. (See handy measuring guide on side of label.) Fill spray bottle with water. Replace gun and follow directions on spray bottle label.

Turn adjustable nozzle by rotating to deliver a fine mist, coarse spray or jet stream. A fine mist spray gives best insect control on plants. Begin early - Make first application when insects first appear. Fog with a slow sweeping motion to cover upper and lower leaf surfaces, and stems. For dense growth, spray from both sides. For Corn Ear Worm, set nozzle to stream and spray into corn silk, and make 3 or 4 applications at 2 to 3 day intervals. Reapply immediately after rain.

For best results, spray early in the morning or evening when air is still. Regular light sprayings are better than single heavy treatments. Repeat as necessary, generally at 7 day intervals. Stop use 1 day before harvest. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90°F.
