The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

For registration 478-76, we have reconsidered the issue regarding the claim - Fresh, Pleasant Odor. Since this claim has been approved since the earliest registration of this pesticide, we will withdraw our comments for the moment. We are still expecting your supplier of the perfume to furnish its composition for our files (see our letter of February 20, 1991).

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin:** Wash contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish and to aquatic organisms in adjacent waters.

Physical and Chemical Hazards


Contents under pressure. Do not use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Sweep in sweeping motion at the rate of 1 cubic yard of space, while moving in areas. Treat porches, patios in similar manner. Spray only when insects dissipate before occupying building. Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting plants.

WASPS: Applications should be made when insects are at rest. Spray in breeding places, contacting insects. Repeat as necessary. Spray under eaves, enter building.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS: Spray insects when possible. Spray in crevices, and other hiding places under appliances, sinks and drains.

ANTS: Spray trails, nest areas when possible. Repeat as necessary.
