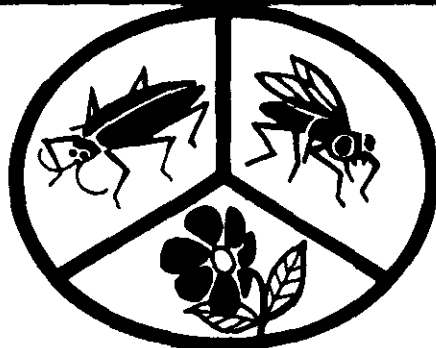

The first multi-purpose household insecticide that can be used for: quick kill of specific flying insects, garden pests and long lasting, 3 to 4 week, control against roaches.

**DIRECTIONS: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING—HOLD CAN UPRIGHT.**

**CRAWLING BUGS** Hold can 18" away and spray baseboards, cracks and crevices, around door and window frames, and other hiding places such as closets, in back of and under appliances, sinks, and cupboards in the kitchen and bathroom. In basements, spray hiding places in cracks and crevices, lower walls, and dark places.

**Ants** Apply to ant trails and around door sills, window frames, and other places where ants may enter.

**FLYING INSECTS** Indoors: Close all doors and windows. Pointing nozzle upward and 3 feet away from surfaces, fill the room with mist. Leave the treated area closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

*Outdoors:* To reduce annoyance from these flying insects and biting flies, hold can 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 3 seconds per cubic yard of space, while moving away from the treated areas. Treat porches, patios, and picnic areas in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

**Wasps** Applications should be made in the evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on wasps that enter building.

**GARDEN PESTS** \*Do not use on food crops. For certain ornamental flowers, spray with a slow, sweeping motion 18" from all plants. Avoid wetting—a light spray kills bugs effectively. Spray plants in short bursts and only when air is still and when temperature is below 90°F. Repeat as needed. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.

For These Ornamentals: Roses, Gladioli, Azaleas, Chrysanthemums, House Plants, Evergreens. Use with caution on azaleas, junipers, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use.

For adult whiteflies and two spotted mites, be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

**CAUTION:** Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

**WARNING:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:** d-trans allethrin (allyl homolog of Cinerin I), 0.150%; t(5-Benzyl-3-furyl) methyl(2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylpropenyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate, 0.350%; Related compounds, 0.048%; aromatic petroleum distillate, 0.484%.
