The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Tetramethrin**, **Phenothrin** REDs and have concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated 9/4/12
- Alt CSF A and B, dated 6/23/2010

Please note that, should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA. 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable



A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. Hold can upright. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from people. Push button to spray. Apply in short bursts.

KILLS THESE COMMON HOUSEHOLD PESTS

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES (Optional: including Aedes aegypti mosquitoes which transmit dengue), SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

COCKROACHES, ANTS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. **To kill ants,** treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.
Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED

GRAIN BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS: Exposed Forms: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets' quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

Use Restrictions

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until the sprays have dried.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

Do not allow people or pets to enter treated areas until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

Wait two (2) hours after application, then open windows, vents and doors for two hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums and ornamental fish ponds before spraying, and turn aquarium systems off.

Do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool place away from heat, direct sunlight, or open flame. 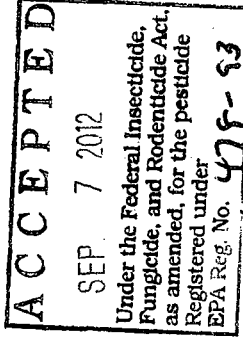
