Your Application Dated September 5, 1997

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the heading "Physical Hazards" to read "Physical or Chemical Hazards". This heading should appear on all labeling and any previously approved labeling with the incorrect heading should be corrected at the next label printing.
2. Per the upcoming final rule for total release foggers add the following statement to Physical or Chemical Hazards: "This product contains a highly flammable ingredient. It may cause a fire or explosion if not used properly. Follow the "Directions for Use" on this label very carefully."
3. Move the user statement "For Household Use Only" to the front panel.
4. Products containing permethrin were never approved for use in the food areas of food handling establishments since permethrin is classified as a category C carcinogen (possible human carcinogen). Therefore as indicated in our October 1, 1997 letter

reinstate under Precautionary Statement or Direction for Use the statement "Do not use in commercial food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed".

- 5. Delete the optional claim "and their hatching eggs". This claim is only appropriate for products in combination with an IGR like methoprene.

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

AUTOMATIC INDOOR FOGGER II

Kills (adult and pre-adult (larvae)) fleas, roaches (cockroaches), palmetto bugs, waterbugs, flies, ants, mosquitoes, spiders, moths, crickets, wasps, hornets, silverfish and ticks.

For use in apartments, homes, attics, basements, garages, pet sleeping areas and cabins.

STOP [STOP!] Read entire label before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling *For household use only.*

TO USE THIS PRODUCT CORRECTLY

Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valve), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) Call your utility or management company if you need assistance.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. One can treats a room up to 25 ft. x 30 ft. with an 8 ft. ceiling.

DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow the fog to enter from other rooms.

BEFORE YOU FOG

Cover or remove exposed food, dishes and food preparation equipment. Open cabinets and doors. Shut off fans and air conditioners and turn off all ignition sources as directed above. Remove pets including birds. Cover and turn off fish tanks. Close outside doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING

- Place several layers of newspaper or paper towels on a table, stand or floor in center of room. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger. Newspapers may be used.

Graphic: Valve locking.

- SHAKE WELL, BEFORE USING. Tilt can top away from face. Press valve all the way down, hooking the catch.
- Set can on newspaper or paper towels and leave the premises immediately. Do not re-enter treated area for two hours.

AIRING OUT

After two hours, open all doors and windows, turn on air conditioner and fans and air out for 30 minutes. Re-apply every two to four weeks if needed.

NOTE: When treating for fleas or ticks, clean and treat pet sleeping areas. Also treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter the treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture container.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist.
