Dear Ms. Mah:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Aet, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. A copy of our review of efficacy data submitted to support this amendment is also enclosed.

- 1. You must delete the following front panel claims:
  - "Keeps [on] killing" (No data were submitted/cited to support residual claims.)
  - "Kills ... stinging ...insects" ("Stinging insects" implies control of wasps, hornets and bees for which you did not submit or cite efficacy data.)
- 2. Revise as shown (revisions are underlined) and move the following statements from the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use:

"All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Do not use in commercial food handling establishments, restaurants or other sites where food is commercially <u>prepared</u>, <u>processed or served</u>.

## AIRING OUT

After two hours, open all doors and windows, turn on air conditioner and fans and air out for 30 minutes. Re-apply every two to four weeks if needed.
