DIRECTIONS

FOR THE USE OF CRYSTOSAN

For the Sanitization of dishes, glassware,
eating and cooking utensils, USE A 3

COMPARTMENT SINK

- I Remove all soil from dishes and glassware. Then wash thoroughly with a good detergent.
