DIRECTIONS: HOW TO OPERATE

Shake can before use and frequently during use. Rotate nozzle to unlock trigger. Invert can and hold about 2 feet from soil. Press trigger firmly to spray Weed Preventer. When finished, hold can upright away from face and press trigger briefly to clear nozzle.

DIRECTIONS: HOW TO USE

Apply Garden Weed Preventer when flowers and other plants are at least 2"-3" tall.

- Remove all existing weeds and cultivate soil before applying.
- Spray soil with bands of Weed Preventer 6"-8" apart. HINT: Do not apply too heavily. Spray the bands at a rate of about 2-3 feet second.
- Rake lightly into soil, being sure to distribute Weed Preventer evenly throughout garden plot.

IMPORTANT: Do not spray on windy days to avoid drift. Do not apply in areas where you wish to plant flowers from seed, as many desirable seeds are sensitive to Weed Preventer. Do not use on ground cover. Not for use on vegetable gardens.

WHERE TO USE: Around trees, shrubs, roses and the following flowers (2"-3" or more in height): Achillea, Aggratum, Arctotis, Aster, Balsam, Calendula, California Poppy, Calliopsis, Carnation, Centaurea, Chrysanthemum, Cosmos, Dahlia, Dianthus, Dimorphotheca, Forget-Me-Not, Four O'Clock, Gaillardia, Hollyhock, Ixora (Coccinea), Lobelia, Lupines, Marigold, Morning Glory, Nasturtium, Nicotiana, Periwinkle, Petunia, Philoxera, Portulaca, Rudbeckia, Salvia, Scabiosa, Shasta Daisy, Snapdragon, Stocks, Snow on the Mountain, Sunflower, Sweet Alyssum, Sweet Pea, Sweet William, Zinnia and Gladiolus corms over 1" in diameter.

WEEDS AND GRASSES CONTROLLED

* **Weeds:** Carelessweed, Carpetweed, Chickweed, Florida Purslane (Pursley), Goosefoot, Knotweed, Kochia, Lambsquarter, Pigweeds (spinach root), Purslane, Russian Thistle, Stinging Nettle.

* **Grasses:** Annual Bluegrass, Barnyardgrass (watergrass), Brachiaria, Bromegrass, Cheat, Crabgrasses, Foxtails, Goosegrass, Johnson grass (from seeds), Junglerice, Sandbur, Stinkgrass, Sprangletop, Texas Panicum, Wildcane.
