

DIRECTIONS

INFUCO DIBROME may be used in the local treatment of infestations of any kind. Treatments should be repeated until the infestation is completely eliminated.

Remove equipment as far as possible before shutting down. Excessive tanks in machines or in a partially filled spout will prevent the fumigant from reaching all parts of the equipment.

Eliminate drafts inside the equipment by closing off connections to any dust collectors which have openings to the outside of the building. Take any other steps necessary to prevent air movement inside the equipment.

Open enough windows in the mill building during the application of INFUCO DIBROME to allow adequate ventilation. Immediately after application, close all doors and windows to reduce drafts in the building during the exposure period.

INFUCO DIBROME may be applied with suitable automatic application equipment or with a portable hand operated applicator calibrated to deliver accurate dosages. Use a closed system applicator only. Use as indicated in the dosage table, paying particular attention to locations where insects tend to gather. Deliver the desired dosages to the various pieces of equipment through perforated quarter-inch holes. Apply INFUCO DIBROME so that the applicator is always working away from the vapors.


Have ready a suitable supply of water for use in the event of a fire. Apply with a suitable mark or sticker to indicate the location of the fumigant container. Do not use the fumigant in areas where the gas may be hazardous to humans or animals. Do not use the fumigant in areas where it may be hazardous to plants. After application, the fumigant should be removed from the area by using the appropriate ventilation system.

Do not breathe the vapor. Wear approved gas mask when releasing gas in confined area or entering an area under gas. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or clothing. Keep away from heat. Keep container closed. Send for a doctor in case of accident.

First aid: In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water, remove and wash clothing before reuse. Do not wear shoes until free of all DIBROME odor.
