Subject: Amendment - Updated Label/Revised Confidential
Statement of Formula
Diarin-5
EPA Registration No. 485-38
Your Letter Dated April 1, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula which will incorporate the following:
 - a. Upper and lower certified limits for all ingredients including inerts.
 - b. The total under column 13.b is 100%. However, when you add the inerts as listed on the label this figures to over 100%. Please correct.
 - c. The chemical name for Diazinon has a spelling error. O,O-diethyl . . . 's correct. Please make this change where required.

2. The print on your label is too small. We assume proper type size will be used on the finished label. Note the signal word "CAUTION" must be a minimum 18 point print size and the child hazard warning must be a minimum 12 point type size. The rest of the text must be of a minimum 6 point type size. When submitting labeling to EPA for review in the future it should be in type size easily readable.
3. Immediately following the product name, on the next line, please add the revised wording, "Only For Sale To, Use And Storage By Pest Control Operators."
4. "Petroleum Distillate" is not considered an active ingredient and must be incorporated as part of the inert ingredients section. Add its percentage to the total inert percentage. In addition add a double asterisk to the subheading "Inert Ingredient**" and another double asterisk on the next line with the wording "Contains Petroleum Distillates."
5. The child hazard statement must precede the signal word on the front label.
6. We suggest the "Statement of Practical Treatment" (SOPT) section be blocked with a solid line.
7. Revise the subheading "IF ON EYES" to "IF IN EYES."
8. Delete the wording "CAUTION KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" which precedes the heading "Precautionary Statements." In addition, following the wording "HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" add the signal word "CAUTION."
9. In the "Precautionary Statements" section delete the wording "May be fatal." In its place use the word "Harmful." Under this same section revise the following sentence to read, "Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking, eating, or drinking."
10. Under the "Environmental Hazards" section delete the sentence, "Keep out of any body of water." In its place add the sentence, "Do not apply directly to water."
11. Add the following wording to the Directions For Use section: "Prior to above applications deenergize electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "On" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surfaces."

12. On the front panel immediately below the SOPT section add the wordin~, "See Side Panel For Additional Precautionary Statements."
