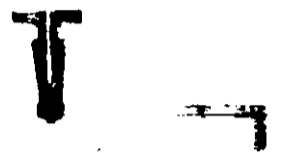

EFFECTIVITY FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

This product is effective against microorganisms in a manner consistent with the following:

PEROCIDE 3905 is effective against bacteria, fungi, and algae in recirculating water systems. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned of scale, sludge, and other deposits. Apply 1.0 gallon of PEROCIDE 3905 per 1000 gallons of water per day. A concentration of 90 to 240 parts per million of PEROCIDE 3905 per gallon of water in the system is recommended. If no visible control is evident:

Apply 1.5 gallons of PEROCIDE 3905 per 1000 gallons of water per day. If no visible control is evident after 3 days, increase the frequency of addition to 2.0 gallons per 1000 gallons of water per day.
