DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing, before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

This Concentrated product is a proven powerful 2 Step Detergent and Disinfectant designed to improve housekeeping in commercial establishments, schools, institutions, hospitals and industry by reducing bacterial contamination, attendant mal odors and filth in these areas.

This product passes the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Confirmation Method at 1:100 for Hospital Disinfection against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*; at 1:128 for General Disinfection against gram positive *Staphylococcus aureus* and gram negative *Salmonella choleraesuis*.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING - To first remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits:
Lightly soiled areas should be cleaned with a solution containing 1 ounce of product per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas should be cleaned with a solution containing 2 to 3 ounces of product per gallon. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION: First assure that all areas (such as walls, floors, tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, metal) are thoroughly cleaned as above to remove organic soils such as blood, fecal matter or exudates. Then disinfect hard nonporous surfaces in medical areas by wiping, brushing or mopping with a fresh solution containing 1% or 1.28 ounces of product diluted to one gallon with soft water. Treated surfaces must remain thoroughly wet for 10 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or if solution becomes visibly dirty.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION in public and commercial areas: First clean area as directed and then apply a solution containing 1 ounce of product per gallon of solution. Thoroughly wet surface for 10 minutes and insure solution remains free of soil. Those surfaces which may later contact food should be rinsed with potable water.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Correct the spelling of the words: (right panel)
Staphylococcus; contamination
 - b. We would prefer that the use dilutions with the Hospital Disinfection section be revised for clarity; e.g., revise the statement
"...containing 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ or 1.28 ounces of product diluted to one gallon..."
to read:
"...containing 1-1/3 ounces of product diluted to one gallon..."
 - c. Delete the statement "Those surfaces which may later contact food should be rinsed with potable water." No data was submitted to support the claim that this product can be used on food contact surfaces.
 - d. Provide adequate use directions for the claim: Deodorizer. For clarity, include the use directions under its own heading within the Directions for Use Section.
 - e. Revise the statement:
General Purpose Disinfecton in public and commercial areas

General Purpose Disinfection in schools, industry and nonmedical institutions.

- f. Revise the statement: (General Purpose Disinfection/section)
"...Then apply a solution containing 1 ounce of product per gallon of solution. Thoroughly wet surface for 10 minutes and insure solution remains free of soil."

to read:

"...Then apply a solution containing 1 ounce of product per gallon of solution to walls, floors and other (inanimate) nonporous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, metal with a cloth or mop. Thoroughly wet surfaces for 10 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when solutions used becomes visibly dirty."

- g. Delete the letter "s" from the statement active ingredient since only one active is declared.
- h. For the label size submitted, the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL heading and the Child Hazard Warning "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" would require a 12 point type size minimum and the signal word DANGER (front panel only) would require an 18 point type size minimum.
- i. Delete the Environmental Hazard Statement. This statement is only required on products intended for outdoor use.
- j. Revise the referral statement to read:
See left panel for Additional Precautionary Statements.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
