DIRECTIONS:

This is an amazingly powerful insecticide which can be applied either with a brush or by spraying. When applied according to directions, it leaves an invisible film which permits effective control of the aforementioned insects. *directly IN CRACKS AND CREVICES*

Roaches: Thoroughly treat either by spraying or painting infested cracks and other hiding or resting places. Also, may be applied to a limited extent on exposed surfaces where roaches will crawl over it when they come out of hiding. This application should be repeated as often as is necessary to maintain effective control.

Silverfish: Treat same as roaches except that particular attention should be given to the treatment of baseboards, areas behind shelving, bookcases and storage areas.

Ants: Treat same as for roaches and in addition, treat thoroughly ant trails and areas around door seals and window frames where these pests may enter the premises. Also desirable to treat openings around water pipes, electrical outlets, baseboards, where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat application as often as is necessary to maintain effective control.

Brown Dog Ticks on Premises: Treat same as for roaches and in addition, pay particular attention to baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Frequency and extended application will depend upon the source and intensity of the infestation. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat pets or other animals with this insecticide.

Carpenter Beetles on Premises: Treat thoroughly local areas of the floor and baseboards, in cracks and under carpets where these insects are found. Treatment of areas on floors, baseboards and shelves in closets is also recommended. Repeat treatment as is necessary to maintain effective control.

CAUTION: REPEATED OR PROLONGED CONTACT WITH SKIN CAN CAUSE TOXIC SYMPTOMS. AVOID EXCESSIVE INHALING OR SKIN CONTACT. IN CASE OF SPILLAGE ON SKIN, WASH WITH SOAP AND WATER. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FEED AND FOODSTUFFS. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

FIRE HAZARD: DO NOT SPRAY INTO OR NEAR FIRE OR OPEN FLAME. DO NOT SMOKE WHILE SPRAYING.

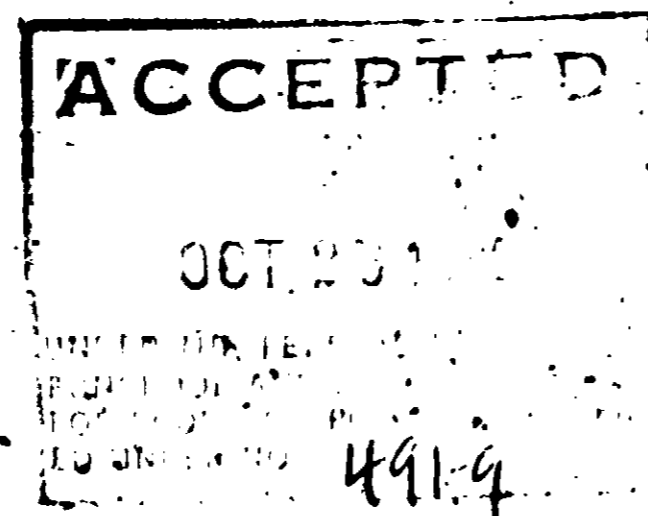

KILLS: ROACHES • ANTS • PALMETTO BUGS • SILVERFISH • SPIDERS • CRICKETS • WATERBUGS in and around the home.

Insect-killing power lasts for weeks, including German cockroaches resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphate insecticides. Spray residues kill insects indoors up to 6 weeks after the spray deposit has dried.

DIRECTIONS: Remove protective cap from valve. Hold can upright and aim long red nozzle away from you and directly at area to be treated. Hold container 6" to 18" away and wet surfaces at the rate of 1 to 2 ft. per second. Leave treated surfaces wet.

ROACHES: Treat all areas where insects are commonly found, behind baseboards, mouldings, furniture, shelves, sinks and pipes. Direct nozzle into cracks, crevices and similar hiding places.

This thorough application is effective for weeks. The residual coating left by this treatment is not easily swept away. However, cleaning with soap and water will remove the application, so re-apply after such cleaning.

SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, WATERBUGS: Spray directly on insects where possible. Treat all areas where insects are commonly found. Direct nozzle into cracks, crevices, and similar hiding places.

ANTS: Direct nozzle on ant trails and wet around door sills and window frames, openings around water pipes, heat ducts and baseboards.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not spray on humans, animals, food or food utensils. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after using. If sprayed on skin, wash off immediately with soap and water. Avoid inhalation. Use in well ventilated room.

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Before spraying, remove goldfish bowls, bird cages, pets, etc.

FLAMMABLE: Do not spray near or toward open flame. Do not smoke while spraying. Do not puncture or incinerate container, or store in temperatures over 100° F.

Do not spray on plastics or asphalt tile, or anything that may be affected by petroleum distillates.
