# SELIG'S STEROLIN DISINFECTANT

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**

Coal Tar Neutral Oils . . . . . 62.50%  
 Soap (Potassium Soap of Coconut Oil) . . . . . 16.50%  
 Cresylic Acid . . . . . 11.00%

**INERT INGREDIENTS:**

Water . . . . . 10.00% (Max.)  
 Phenol Coefficient - 6 (AOAC Method S Typhosa)

**USE DIRECTIONS:**

Mix one part STEROLIN with 120 parts water for use as a disinfectant to clean toilet rooms, wash basins, toilet bowls and other toilet fixtures. Areas to be cleaned should be thoroughly saturated with the above use dilution for proper germicidal action.

**WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May produce severe burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after using.

**ANTIDOTES:** Internally: give raw egg white, milk, mucilage, or cornstarch and follow with emetic or mustard. Call a physician. External: wash with water and alcohol.
