The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Remove "Essential Oils" from the active ingredient section, and place in the inert ingredients. Adjust your inert percentages accordingly.
2. Include a 10-minute contact time for disinfection.
3. Delete the "service persons" statement on the front panel.
4. Delete the word "milk."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.



GENERAL DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from premises or utensils to be disinfected. Then wet all surfaces with a solution of 1 1/2 ounce LEM-O-DIS per gallon of water. This solution acts as a disinfectant against S. Typhosa, S. Aureus and Pseudomonas Aeruginosa when used as directed.

MOPPING: Use LEM-O-DIS in mopping solutions of 1 1/2 oz. to 1 gallon of water.

TOILET BOWLS: First thoroughly clean, then remove residual water from bowl prior to the application of the recommended solution, for general disinfecting.

Statement of Practical Treatment
