The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

- Update First Aid statements per PR Notice 2001-1

**Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

1. Create a "**Physical and Chemical Hazards**" section and place the statement, "*Do not use with soap or anionic detergents,*" underneath the heading.
2. The use site, "institutions," is too broad. You must be more specific as to where this product may be used.
3. Revise the "Toilet bowl" directions to read "*Remove gross filth before disinfection. Empty toilet bowl or urinal. Apply 1 1/2 oz per gallon use solution to exposed surfaces and under the rim with a cloth, mop, sponge, or brush. Brush or swab thoroughly especially under the rim. Allow to stand 10 minutes, then flush.*"
4. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to reflect the current language in the Label Manual, 2<sup>nd</sup> Editions by stating "*Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective clothing, goggles or faceshield, and rubber gloves. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse*"



Pre-clean surfaces. Then, thoroughly wet surfaces using a mop, cloth, or sponge. Surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow surfaces to air dry or rinse/dry excess solution from surfaces. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if the use solution becomes visibly soiled or diluted. After disinfecting food contact surfaces such as tables and counters, rinse surfaces with potable water. Do not use on utensils, glasses, dishes, or cookware. **TOILET BOWLS:** First thoroughly clean, then remove residual water from bowl prior to the application of the recommended solution for general disinfecting.
