1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Change protroleum distillates to singular as suggested in our letter of August 8, 1985.
- b. Change "Warning" to "Caution" on side panel as indicated in comment 5 of our last letter.
- c. Either delete the word "plus" in the product name or identify what the plus refers to.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling

COCKROACHES, ANTS & SILVERFISH—Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and similar area where these insects hide. Under conditions of heavy cockroach infestation, repeat the application within twenty-four hours, then set up monthly application schedule or as needed.

BROWN DOG TICKS & FLEAS ON PREMISES—Thoroughly spray localized infestations in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation; repeating the applications as infestations warrant and as re-infestation occurs. Do not apply to animals directly
