### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Pyrethrins . . . . .	.30%
*Piperonyl butoxide, technical . . . . .	.60%
N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide . . . . .	1.00%
Petroleum distillate . . . . .	1.44%

**INERT INGREDIENTS:** . . . . . 96.66%

\* (Butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and related compounds.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Space Spray to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying Moths:** Pour in sprayer. Close doors and windows and turn off ventilating equipment. Mist all parts of the room or area at a dosage of one fluid ounce of dilute spray per 3000 cubic feet of space. Repeat as needed.

**Contact Spray to Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets and Exposed Forms of Crawling Grain Pests:** Apply as a coarse spray to all cracks and crevices in woodwork, beneath sinks, dark places behind pipes and in all places where these insects nest, contacting as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat applications as often as necessary to gain control. For grain weevils, cadelles, grain moths, flour beetles and grain mites apply as a coarse spray to all infested surfaces, insect hiding places and insect runways at the rate of one gallon of dilute spray on 2000 square feet of area. Repeat when necessary.

## CAUTION:

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**

Use product as space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly washed with potable water before using. Keep containers closed. Remove birds and fishbowls from room being sprayed.
