mites as well as for washing and cleaning your dogs. Bathe dog in a receptacle or tub large enough to cover the entire body of the dog with the exception of the head. Mix a solution made of one part SELCOPINE DOG DIP to 50 parts water, which gives a 1.6% solution of pine oil. Before dipping dog, place a drop of castor oil in each eye for protection against splashing. Allow the dog to stand in dip for several minutes but do not put his head under. Take a cloth or rag and wash head and ears well taking care not to get any solution in the eyes by holding your hand over the dog's eyes while washing the head. Dip and wash dogs twice weekly during warm weather.

KENNELS: When above dipping is finished, use a fresh solution of 1 part SELCOPINE DOG DIP to 50 parts water to clean and wash all surfaces thoroughly. Sprinkle some of this solution on the ground around kennel to deodorize. DO NOT USE ON CATS.
