DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Fogging: Read the entire label before using this product. For thermal fog application mix 1 gallon of this product with 10 gallons of fuel oil, diesel oil, kerosene, or other base oils suitable for this use. Apply with a standard fogging machine calibrated to deliver 40 gallons per hour at a machine speed of 5 miles per hour to cover a swath width of up to 350 feet. Repeat as necessary.

Airplane Application: For airplane application mix 1 gallon of this product with 7 gallons of oil as above. Apply 1 gallon of the diluted mixture per acre treated. Allow at least three weeks between applications.

Larva Control: Apply 1/2 pint per acre undiluted or in sufficient oil (1 part concentrate to 23 parts of oil or total volume of 1 1/2 gallon diluted spray per acre) to obtain a light uniform spray. Allow at least three weeks between applications.

MIXING

To mix with oil pour the required amount of this product into full amount of oil and then agitate.
