

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

WARNING

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid skin and eye contact. Avoid breathing spray mist. DO NOT apply directly to food in commercial food handling facilities. Cover or remove any food or food processing equipment during application. DO NOT apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before reuse.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. DO NOT apply directly to water. DO NOT apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
