Inhibits the growth of most germs on treated surfaces. Residual bacteriostatic activity lasts for one month.

For control of mildew on the above hard surfaces, clean and then spray to moisten the surface. Repeat treatment weekly.

DIRECTIONS: Hold dispenser upright - 8" to 10" from surface - spray surface for 3-4 seconds until thoroughly damp. Do not use on polished wood, furniture, or rayon fabrics.
