Chase-MM Patio Patrol Outdoor Insect Fogger
EPA Reg. No. 498-87
Submission dated August 24, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated August 24, 1990 is acceptable, and a copy has been placed in the respective file. If the flash point/flame extension results were achieved as a result of testing indicated in the Agency's letter of June 7, 1990, then your labels must be revised to indicate "Extremely flammable" with all applicable hazards. Your comments concerning PR Notices 87-8 and 87-11 would only apply to products that were indisputably labeled "Extremely flammable" solely on the basis of their containing hydrocarbon or ether propellants. Your product, however, is to be labelled such based on the results indicated and the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 156.10 (h)(2)(iii).

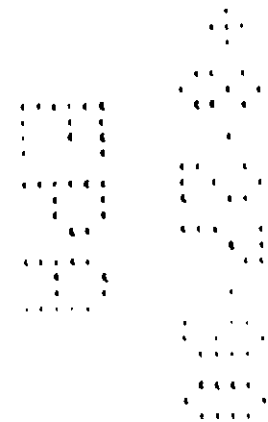

BACK PANEL

Spray outdoor areas of the yard, patio and camp ground when there is no breeze or spray in the direction of slight breeze. Controls flies, mosquitoes and gnats up to 21 feet away, using this fog nozzle.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Harmful if swallowed. Not for indoor use. While spraying for flying insects outdoors, hold container 4 to 6 feet away from plants and shrubs. Direct spray to fill the air around these plants without heavily wetting the plant foliage. Avoid smoking while spraying. Cover food before spraying. Do not spray on food crops. Direct spray away from people or animals. Allow spray to disperse for several minutes before entering the treated area.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes). Drift and run off from treated sites maybe hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOT FOR INDOOR USE. Shake well before using. Point spray nozzle away from face and in the direction of the space to be treated. Press down valve button and allow spray fog to fill the air where flying pests linger. For larger areas, best results are obtained by spraying in the direction of slight breeze that allows the fog to drift into the areas of infestation. Spray while moving away from treated areas. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS. Reduce annoyance from flies, mosquitoes, moths and gnats by directing spray from a distance of 4 to 6 feet from flowering plants, shrubbery, and grass to where the insects may be resting. Avoid heavy wetting of plant foliage. Also spray around garbage cans and other breeding areas. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on wasps and hornets. Thoroughly wet the nesting area during the evening when these insects are least active.

CRAWLING INSECTS. Spray directly on ants, centipedes, sowbugs, and spiders. Treat areas around garbage cans, picnic sites and camp grounds infested by these pests. Also thoroughly spray ant hills

for best results. Spray in short bursts of 2 seconds at 4 to 6 feet distance for control of Brown Recluse Spider and Black Widow Spider. Repeat application as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
