  - b. Under "Contact time", the statement should read: Leave surface wet for \_\_\_\_\_ minutes. This contact time will not control other common types of viruses and bacteria.
  - c. Under Directions for Mold and Mildew, change "spray six inches for surface . . ." to read "spray six inches from surface . . .".
  - d. The referral statement on the front panel must be changed to read: "See precautionary statements on back on can."



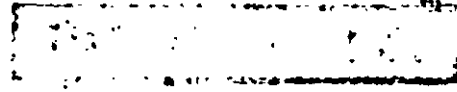

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

498-97

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kills HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood and body fluids.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD AND BODY FLUIDS on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids in health care settings (or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of HIV.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: When handling items soiled with blood or body fluids use appropriate barrier protection, such as disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks or eye coverings.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this disinfectant.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to Federal, State, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

DIRECTIONS: FOR KILLING HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS): After surface is cleaned, hold can upright and spray six to eight inches from surface to be treated until surface becomes wet. Allow spray to dry without wiping or allow spray to contact treated surface for a minimum of ten minutes prior to wiping.

DIRECTIONS: FOR DISINFECTION OF INANIMATE SURFACES

This disinfectant spray is a powerful germicidal that kills Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

Use to disinfect urinals, toilet seats, wash bowls, shower stalls, telephones, empty hampers diaper pails, athletic equipment, light switches, garbage cans and lockers.

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Clean object to be sprayed using usual cleaning methods. Hold dispenser upright and spray six inches from surface until surface is wet.

It is also effective against fungi such as Trichophyton interdigitale (causes of ring worm or athletes foot), not intended to topical application to the body.

**DIRECTIONS: FOR CONTROL OF MOLD & MILDEW**

Prevent mold and mildew on hard surfaces such as ceramic, metal, glass in basement closets, attic storage areas, summer cottages.

Clean object by usual cleaning methods. Hold dispenser upright and spray six inches for surface until surface is wet. Repeat application when new growth appears.

**DIRECTIONS: FOR SPACE DEODORIZER & AIR FRESHENER**

Use to deodorize meeting room, class room, kitchen, bathroom, sick room, living room, and churches.

Hold can upright and point valve opening away from face. Spray upwards for three seconds into corner as well as center of room, filling room with mist.

**C A U T I O N:** Avoid contact with the eyes and skin. If sprayed into eyes, wash with water. If irritation persists, consult your Physician. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contamination of food stuff. Keep out of reach of children.

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Do not spray on varnished, painted or plastic surface.

**S T O R A G E:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

**D I S P O S A L:** Replace cap. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
