The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, under section 3(c)(7)(A), to include an additional organism-, is acceptable, provided that you.

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Under the directions for use, delete the wording "Powerful".

b. Delete "... not intended to topical application to the body" and replace with "... in appropriate areas such as shower room floors, locker room benches, or bath mats ...".

c. The use directions should be expanded to reflect item #3 of DIS/TSS-15 enclosure.

d. Move the statement "contains sodium nitrite" and placed immediately below the ingredient statement.

e. Move the child hazard warning statement and the signal word to follow directly after the statement "contains sodium nitrite". (front panel only)

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD AND BODY FLUIDS on pre-cleaned environmental surfaces/objects previously soiled with blood/body fluids in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of HIV.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: When handling items soiled with blood or body fluids use appropriate barrier protection such as disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks or eye coverings.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this Disinfectant.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to Federal, State, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

CONTACT TIME: Leave surface wet for 10 minutes.

After surface is cleaned, hold can upright and spray six to eight inches from surface to be treated until surface becomes wet.

Allow spray to dry without wiping, or allow spray to contact treated surface for a minimum of ten minutes prior to wiping.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF INANIMATE SURFACES

This Disinfectant Spray is a powerful germicidal that kills Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa and Streptococcus pyogenes.

Use to disinfect urinals, toilet seats, wash bowls, shower stalls, telephones, empty hampers, diaper pails, athletic equipment, light switches, garbage cans and lockers.

Clean object to be sprayed using usual cleaning methods. Hold dispenser upright and spray six inches from surface until surface is wet. Allow Disinfectant Spray to remain on the surface for 10 minutes before wiping off.

It is also effective against fungi such as Trichophyton interdigital (caused of ring worm or athletes foot), not intended to topical application to the body.

DIRECTIONS FOR CONTROL OF MOLD & MILDEW

Prevent mold and mildew on hard surfaces such as ceramic, metal, glass in basement closets, attic storage areas, summer cottages.

Clean object by usual cleaning methods. Hold dispenser upright and spray six inches from surface until surface is wet. Repeat application when new growth appears.

DIRECTIONS FOR SPACE DEODORIZER & AIR FRESHENER

Use to deodorize meeting room, class room, kitchen, bathroom, sick room, living room, and churches.

Hold can upright and point valve opening away from face. Spray upwards for three seconds into corner as well as center of room, filling room with mist.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with the eyes and skin. If sprayed into eyes, wash with water. If irritation persists, consult your Physician. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contamination of food stuff. Keep out of reach of children.
