PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Hazard if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if serious persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, only or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After spray spraying in most packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Webbing Clothes Moths and Gnats

Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible directly with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected to harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants, treat doors, window sills, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for control.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Borer, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps: Contact insects directly with spray. Sweep up and discard fallen wasps. Repeat as necessary.
