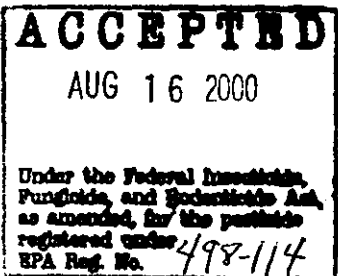
(GRAPHICS OF MOSQUITO & HOUSEFLY)

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

(GRAPHICS OF HOUSE CRICKET & BLACK ANT)

INDOORS: To kill flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats and wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To kill cockroaches, ants and crickets: contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill carpet beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS: To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats and small flying moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow, sweeping motion at the rate of 1-3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open decks, porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To kill common ornamental plant pests, Japanese beetles, aphids, mealybugs, tent caterpillars: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new, tender growth on young plants.

WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when the air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow, sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at a rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.

To protect woolen articles: Brush woolen articles. Clean, air and remove persistent spots and stains by dry cleaning. Holding dispenser at least 2 feet from the garment, spray thoroughly. Treated articles should be put in a darkened closet or other darkened storage area. For best protection, clean and spray insides of closets or storage units for 30-40 seconds before putting treated articles away. This will kill the larvae and adults of carpet beetles and clothes moths. Treatment should be repeated every 6 months or as needed. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.
