Subject: Amendment - Revised Labeling  
SprayPak Ant & Roach Killer 2  
EPA Registration No. 498-121  
Your Letter Dated March 20, 1990

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the Note to Physician as follows:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

2. Please revise the statement beginning with "Do not use in commercial food..." as follows:

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

3. Delete the phrase "prevents reinfestation for weeks" from the back panel. Terms implying that protection will extend for an indefinite period are not acceptable. The duration of effectiveness should be established by testing, and then included on the label.

## BACK PANEL

SprayPak Ant & Roack Killer spray kills with residual action and prevents reinfestation for weeks. In the event the insecticide film becomes ineffective, repeat treatment.

### **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. If swallowed, get immediate medical attention. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not apply to humans or pets. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use, and before eating or smoking. Do not smoke while using. Keep out of reach of children; do not allow children or pets in treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible product areas of food processing plants/or in serving areas while in operation or when food is exposed. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not spray more than 1 1/2 minutes in average room. Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds.

### **PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove cap. Hold container as upright as possible. Point spray opening away from you and press button. Hold dispenser about 6 inches to one foot from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. FOR SPOT APPLICATION ONLY. DO NOT USE as a space spray.

For Indoor Use: Cockroaches, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Scorpions, Waterbugs: Spray thoroughly into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, plumbing and other places where insects hide. Apply behind and beneath refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails and places where ants enter premises.

Brown Dog Ticks: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarter after spraying. Do not spray animals.

For Outdoor Use: Spiders, Crickets, Ants, Clover Mites, Earwigs, Fleas,

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millipedes, sowbugs, brown dog ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter or harbour. For ants, spray hills and runways.

When using indoors, avoid wetting asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials. When using outdoors, do not spray desirable vegetation.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

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
