## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Please provide the following product chemistry information:

- a) A brief description of the formulating process--order of mixing, temperature, etc.
- b) Certified limits for the inert ingredients.
- c) Provide or reference data which would demonstrate storage stability.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

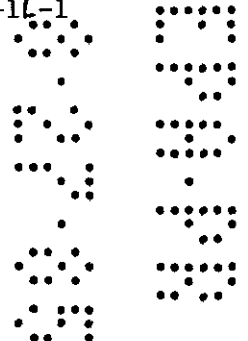

SPRAYPAK Wasp, Bee and Hornet Killer with Propoxur and DDVP kills fast. Vaporizing action of DDVP penetrates into nests and under eaves to kill hornets and wasps. It kills with residual action and prevents reinfestation for weeks. In the event the insecticide film becomes ineffective repeat treatment.

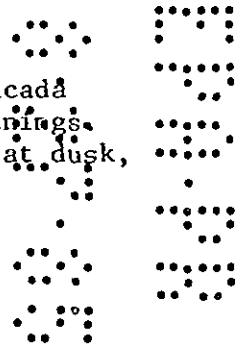
Directions: Spray 2 ways

For spray mist - Press half-way down  
For 12-foot jet - Press all the way down

Remove cap. Hold container as upright as possible. Point spray opening away from you and press button. Spray until surfaces are wet.

FOR SPOT APPLICATION ONLY. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY.

Hornets, wasps (such as yellow jackets, mud Daubers), Bees and Cicada Killers: Spray a stream directly on nests, especially around openings. The stream can be directed 6 to 12 feet. Apply to nesting areas at dusk,



when possible, since most insects are then in their nests and less active. Spray around window and door frames, under shutters, under eaves and siding, around rafters and other areas where Wasps and Hornets may nest. Repeat applications when necessary.

Garbage cans for Yellow Jackets and Flies: A thorough spraying inside garbage can will help control Yellow Jackets which may frequent the area and will kill flies. The DDVP will give vaporizing action if the garbage can is slightly covered. Re-applications should be made when insects reappear.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
