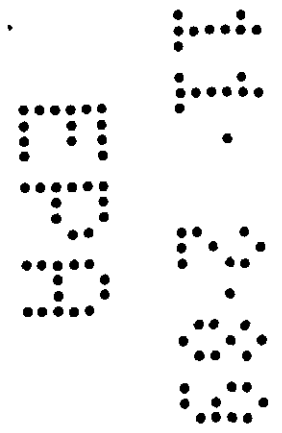
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

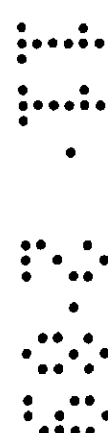
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product can be used both indoors (attics and other places nests are built) and outdoors on Wasp and Hornet nests.

DIRECTIONS: Remove protective cap. Point nozzle toward nest, crevice, or hole where infestation or insects are known to be inside. For indoor use, spray from 12 to 18 inches away from nest, crevice or hole. For outdoor use, Wasp Killer can be used 20 feet away. Press valve all the way down and spray. This treated surface will have a residual killing action and prevent reinfestation for weeks in the event the insecticide film becomes ineffective due to rain or other causes, repeat treatment. Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at nest. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. With wind at back, aim at nest. Thoroughly saturate nest with spray, contacting as many insects as possible. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under the nest. Do not spray vegetation. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment. Do not use as a space spray.

When using indoors avoid wetting asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
