PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

To Kill Gnats, Hornets, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Sandflies, Small Flying Moths, Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into the center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

To Kill Ants, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting directly as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails around windows and door sills and any other location ants are seen. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Pets should be treated with a registered product for control of ticks and fleas before reentering treated areas. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles, Clothes Moths: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in moth-proof containers.
