Dear Ms. Hernandez:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Revise your "Precautionary Statements" section to read: "Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse." Move the statements "Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs. Do not use...covered or removed. Remove ...before spraying" to the "Directions for Use" section of your label.
- 2. Revise your "First Aid" section to include the following statements:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

- 3. Under the "First Aid" section, add a "Note to Physician " section and insert the following statement: "Contains petroleum distillate vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
- 4. Either delete the phrase "Repeat as necessary" or indicate a time period for follow-up application based upon the residual efficacy of the product.
- 5. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
