- Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

 - Delete the statement under the Hazards to Humans C. Domestic Animals and replace with following:

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before smoking sensitization May cause contact following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. 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sensitization reactions results, contact a physician. Do not spray household pets or humans with this product. d. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, make the following changes:

Revise the last statement under IF SWALLOWED to read:

Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

Add the following NOTE TO PHYSICIAN section:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

e. Replace the first paragraph of the Environmental Hazards statement with the following:

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water.

f. Under the Directions For Use, replace the last statement in the first paragraph, "Do not use as a space spray." with the following statements:

Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray. Apply as a localized surface spray only. Take care not to introduce this product into the air during Use only in well-ventilated areas. application. Do not apply this pesticide when occupants are present i the immediate area. Do not apply this pesticide when classrooms are in use. Do not apply this pesticide in occupied patient rooms or in any room occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. Before spraying this product, remove or cover all exposed food, and remove pests and cover fish aquariums.

spray plants, pets, or humans. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during spraying or thoroughly washed with soap and water before reuse. Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Do not use in conduits, motor housing, or electrical switch boxes.

- g. In the directions for crack and crevice application in food processing establishments, replace "...using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide." with "...using an injection or insertion tube." Presumably, such a tube is already included with this aerosol product as marketed. Please confirm this.
- h. In the directions for control of ants, etc., delete "and other utility installations", since the could be construed as recommending spraying into areas where electrical contact could occur, which is not acceptable for a water-based product.
- i. At the end of the outdoor sections, add the statement: "Do not spray lawns, desirable plants, or shrubbery with this product."
- j. Delete "For Commercial/Industrial Use Only" on the front panel.
- k. On page 11 add "or Spot Treatment" to the heading "...Crack and Crevice Treatment or Spot Treatment Are Not Permitted".
- .j. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" or submit an application to USDA requesting these areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.
- 3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

FEED AND FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS CRACK AND CREVICE AND SPOT TREATMENTS:

Apply as either a spot or crack and crevice treatment in Food Handling Establishments (places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served) as directed below.

Food/feed areas including, but not limited to, areas for receiving storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing foods, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation): Use as a crack and crevice treatment in and around both food and nonfood areas to control Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Waterbugs.

Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide. In points between different elements of contruction, expinsion joints, between equipment and floor, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to epplication, de-energize electrical equipment. Limit spot treatments to floor surfaces, where pests have been seen or where they are duspected of hiding. Limit individual spot treatments to an area no larger than 20% of the floor surface. Individual spot treatments shall not exceed two square feet. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will come in contact with food. Take extreme care to avoid contamination of food or food contact surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

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APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD MANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREASMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Application Within Food Serving Areas (facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held): Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

INDOOR USE:

To kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrets, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Spiders: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of the rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails and points of entry.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, and nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, windows and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

OUTDOOR USE:

To control Houseflies, Gnats, Hornets, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Noths, Wasps and Yellow Jackets: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and Mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

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
