

- The statement must read, "One 6 ounce aerosol can treat e. 6000 cubic feet of unobstructed area . . .
- Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

- * Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table
- * Shut off electrical equipment .
- * Place cans at least 6 feet from pilot lights

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thorougly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Nonfood/nonfeed areas include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

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One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8' ceiling).

For Fleas and Ticks use one 6 ounce can for every 1,500 cubic feet of room space.

HOW TO USE

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (Newspapers may be used). Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use more than one ounce of product per 1000 cubic feet of space.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER

SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. NOTE: Do NOT place fogger on water-stainable surface. Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
