The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the MGK-264, Piperonyl butoxide, and Allethrin REDs and has concluded that your submission is acceptable

NOTE This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156 140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

TO KILL ANTS, BLACK WIDOW SPIDERS, CARPET BEETLES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SOW BUGS AND SPIDERS Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance
