PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.
- IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Wash skin soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air if effects occur, and call a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in non-food areas indoors and outside premises of hotels, motels, homes, preschools, day camps, lathhouses, food handling establishments, packing and processing plants, commercial, institutional and storage buildings, dairies, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Also for use in campers, mobile homes, buses, automobiles, trucks, and boxcars.

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SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT

I N D O O R S

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths. Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Close all doors and windows and direct spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Rice Weevils, Saw Toothed Grain Beetles, Ticks: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting directly as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails around windows and door sills and any other location ants are seen. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Pets should be treated with a registered product for control of ticks and fleas before reentering treated areas. Repeat as necessary.

O U T D O O R S

TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS: Kill mosquitoes, houseflies, and flying moths by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from flying insects treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray trails, nests and point of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

S T O R A G E A N D D I S P O S A L

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

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
