2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 498-175".
- b. Include as a footnote to the inert ingredients the following statement:  
Contains petroleum distillates, xylene, or xylene range aromatic solvent.
- c. Change the signal word to "WARNING" in both places where it appears on the label.

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d. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:  
Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

e. The Statement of Practical Treatment must be revised to read as follows:

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

f. Add to the first paragraph of the directions for use the following:  
If you go to a doctor, take this product with you.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

4. Submit a confidential statement of formula revised to state the purpose of propylene glycol (col. 16) in the formulation.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

To repel the listed insects, apply just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. To apply to face, spray into hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin irritations in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.

Do not spray in enclosed areas.
