The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of SPRAYPAK INSECT REPELLENT 3 (EPA Reg. No. 498-175), in connection with the MGK 326 Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED), and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

General Comment(s):

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough"

Ingredient Statement section comment(s):

<u>Precautionary Statements section. Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection</u> comment(s):

3. Replace the sentence "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." With "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

First Aid Section:

4. Replace this section with:

- 5. In the 7th" sentence, replace the words "hands and rub on." with the words "palm of hands and then apply sparingly, and avoid eyes."
- 6. Add the following statements per the MGK 326 RED document:
 - "Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under."
 - "Do not spray directly onto face. Spray hands first and then use hands to wipe spray onto face."

Environmental Hazard Section:

7. Add a new Environmental Hazards section as follows:

Environmental Hazards

"This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate."

Store this product away from open heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.

Current labels on DEET repellent products tend to dissolve from contact with the repellent (usually liquids). All reregistered DEET product labels must use materials that remain permanent and readable for the reasonable life of the product. The Agency determined in the DEET RED document that all aerosol and pump spray formulations must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA section 4(g) at this time. A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Do not apply near eyes or mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Repeat as needed. For ticks and children, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in

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clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this product with you.
