- c. Under "Directions for Use" delete use directions for "Cracks and Crevices". This statement is lacking on the label of the cited product.
- d. Under "Physical and Chemical Hazards" <u>add</u>"Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard".
- 3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food-processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food-processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Wash with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air if effects occur, and call a physician.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

FOR SPACE SPRAY:

TO KILL FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND WASPS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES AND CRICKETS: Contact as many insects as

possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS AND SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Find and destroy infected package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, SOW BUGS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove and destroy pets' old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

FOR CRACKS AND CREVICES:

TO KILL ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CARPET BEETLES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FLEAS, SILVERFISH, SOW BUGS AND SPIDERS: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above-listed insects hide.

Avoid contamination of food or food-processing surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
